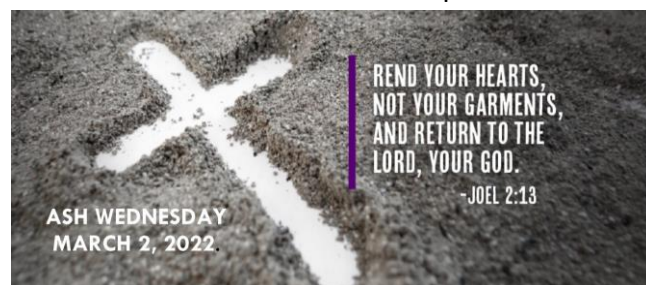
### Ash Wednesday Mass Schedule

### Scrip Sale this Thursday and Friday!

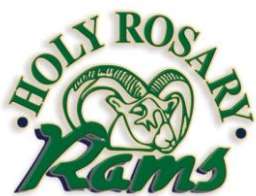

(We began this study in Lent 2020, but stopped due to COVID.)

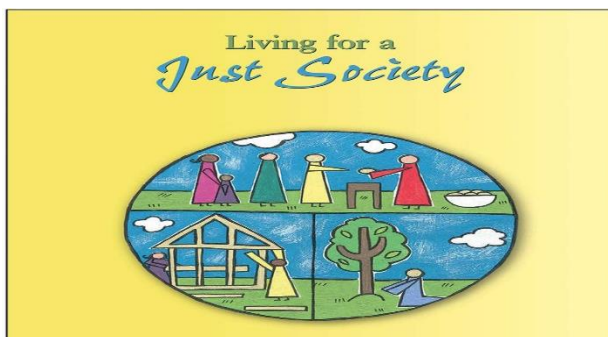
