Once in college, Scholars receive support to complete their college degrees and connect to career opportunities. 7th and 8th grade Indiana students whose families meet income eligibility guidelines can apply to become a 21st Century Scholar. 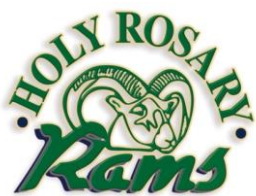

***Just Thinking* by Dr. James Schroeder**

Dr. Mitch Prinstein, the Chief Science Officer for the American Psychological Association (APA), has been working over the past few years to really help all people understand the tremendous risks inherent in technology, especially social media use, despite any benefits that do exist. Dr. Prinstein says, "We have already seen how this has created tremendous vulnerabilities to our way of life. It's even scarier to consider how this may be changing brain development for an entire generation of youth. Our brains were not built for this kind of social interaction. And social media is kind of hijacking the need for social interaction with something artificial and insufficient. Social media is the empty calories of social interaction."

Yet despite all of the undeniable research documenting significant negative effects of technology on our youth (and ourselves), many professionals and those in the general public remain fearful of really speaking to the truth of the matter. The Just Thinking feature for the month entitled "Don't Be Afraid: We All Deserve to Know the Truth About Tech" examines this issue, and looks at why this fear is so costly for our kids and our community. 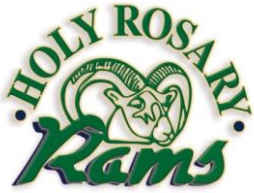

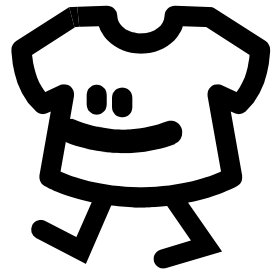

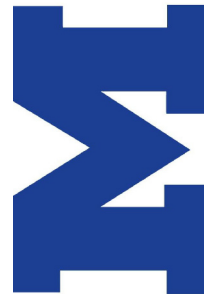
