Totally Essential Products Extravaganza

November 14-18, 2022

Families may send in items with their students Monday-Friday, November 14-18. They will be counted and sorted by our Student Lighthouse team in the Church Annex building. If you have a large amount of items that is too big or heavy for your child to carry, you may drop the items off at the Annex building north of the church at morning drop-off.

All items collected will be shared with families in need this holiday season. They will be packaged into baskets for the Holy Rosary Giving Tree Project.

In order to better assist the families we are helping, we ask that Holy Rosary School families avoid purchasing Ramen noodles and items in glass containers. Products are to be regular sized (not travel), and toilet paper must be at least a 4-roll pk.

1 Point – Awarded for items such as canned or boxed:

2 Points – Awarded for items such as household items:

- **“Souper” Friday** (canned soup)

Safe Environment for Youth Protection

Holy Rosary School Volunteers

The Catholic Diocese of Evansville has a new and enhanced Safe Environment tracking and training system, CMG Connect. ALL school, parish, and diocesan volunteers are required to complete the new training and submit to a criminal background check before they may begin employment or volunteering.

REQUIRED EDUCATION

"Safe Haven-It's Up to You" is a three-part video that provides vignettes of real-life situations to educate the viewer about methods of grooming, desensitization, bullying, and neglect, all of which can lead to abuse. Each part is followed by a brief questionnaire to further develop understanding. The initial safe environment curriculum is approximately 55 minutes. (Note: it will start you from the beginning of each three-part video if the section is not completed.)

YEARLY RENEWALS

All individuals must complete the mandatory online refresher training each year upon the year anniversary of the prior training and submit a new background check every 5 years as a condition of continued ministry and/or continued employment in the Diocese of Evansville. The annual refresher training will be up to you to complete and takes about 12 minutes.

- If you have volunteered and completed a background check within the past FIVE years, you may be able to login with an existing account:

Username: (first name as it appears on your driver's license) Firstname.Lastname.evdio
Password: (initial password) 1234
- If this does not work, you will need to create an account by using the same username format and password. Please complete all required fields.
- You will be prompted to update to a more secure password upon clicking "Log Me In." Once the new password is saved, return to the sign-in page to access your account with your updated credentials.

Your dashboard will show you two sections.

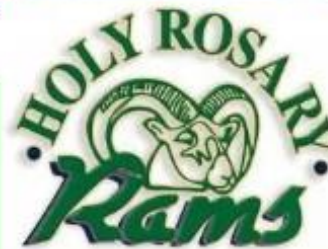
- A. Background Check (GOLD box) – Only select to have a background check if have not completed a background check screening in the last FIVE years through the diocese or Holy Rosary School.
- B. Safe Environment Curriculum (BLUE box) – You will see the required and optional training curriculums that have been customized for your particular category within the Diocese. The Safe Environment Training includes:
 - Safe Haven - It's Up to You videos and questionnaires
 - Diocese Code/Policy
 - Acknowledgement Questions

Once you have completed the Safe Environment Training, you will see a certificate. Select "**send to your coordinator**" or you can print a copy of the certificate from your dashboard and give to me to acknowledge you have completed the training. 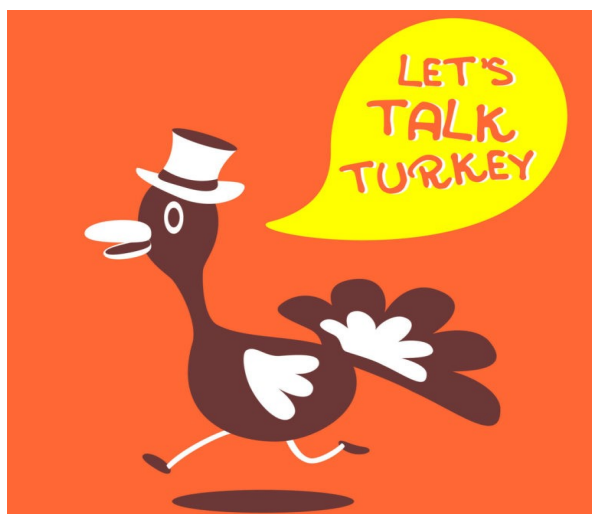

## Nominate an Outstanding Educator

Educators are the heart of our school system. They nurture our children's inquisitive minds and prepare them for future challenges. The Outstanding Educators of the Year award acknowledges the dedication and contributions of Vanderburgh County educators by recognizing four individuals who excel within their profession. Every year, one educator in each of the following categories is named an outstanding educator:

- **Elementary School Teacher (K-5)**
- **Middle School Teacher (6-8)**
- **High School Teacher (9-12)**
- **Building Principal**

## Who is Eligible

Vanderburgh County teachers and building principals employed by a recognized school organization are eligible. Nominees must be current full-time classroom teachers or building principals, grades K-12, who have completed at least three full years of service.

## How Educators are Selected

The selection committee, composed of educators, former educators, and business and community leaders, reviews applications and narrows the field for classroom observations and interviews.

## Winners Receive

- A \$1,000 cash award
- Recognition at the School of Education Recognition Ceremony to be held April 27, 2023, at the University of Evansville

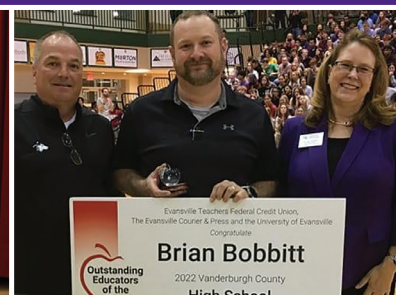
