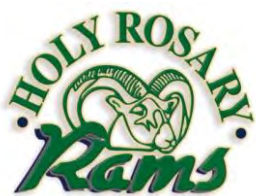

Safe Environment for Youth Protection

Holy Rosary School Volunteers

The Catholic Diocese of Evansville has a new and enhanced Safe Environment tracking and training system, CMG Connect. ALL school, parish, and diocesan volunteers are required to complete the new training and submit to a criminal background check before they may begin employment or volunteering.

REQUIRED EDUCATION

"Safe Haven-It's Up to You" is a three-part video that provides vignettes of real-life situations to educate the viewer about methods of grooming, desensitization, bullying, and neglect, all of which can lead to abuse. Each part is followed by a brief questionnaire to further develop understanding. The initial safe environment curriculum is approximately 55 minutes. (Note: it will start you from the beginning of each three-part video if the section is not completed.)

YEARLY RENEWALS

All individuals must complete the mandatory online refresher training each year upon the year anniversary of the prior training and submit a new background check every 5 years as a condition of continued ministry and/or continued employment in the Diocese of Evansville. The annual refresher training will be up to you to complete and takes about 12 minutes.

- If you have volunteered and completed a background check within the past FIVE years, you may be able to login with an existing account:

Username: (first name as it appears on your driver's license) Firstname.Lastname.evdio
Password: (initial password) 1234
- If this does not work, you will need to create an account by using the same username format and password. Please complete all required fields.
- You will be prompted to update to a more secure password upon clicking "Log Me In." Once the new password is saved, return to the sign-in page to access your account with your updated credentials.

Your dashboard will show you two sections.

Project Descriptions

Kindergarten – We discussed that a symbol is an object that reminds us of something else, and how doves are a symbol of peace and the Holy Spirit in the Catholic faith. We also discussed how oil and water do not mix. We first looked at flying white doves, and then created a simple line drawing using oil pastels. We watched the repelling action of how liquid watercolor paints glide over our oil pastel drawings and then finally we sprayed the art with vibrant watercolor pigments.

1st Grade – We talked about how God takes care of us, and guides us, sometimes without us knowing He is there. The students retold the story of Noah, including what they remembered of Noah sending out birds to look for dry land. They remembered that a dove found a twig and they remembered that God sent a rainbow to remind Noah of hope and His love. Using yarn and a twig we found outside, the students created a rainbow using a simple Macramé knot. After the twig had many colors, we added felt symbols to the twig. Some students created a dove, some flowers, and others clouds.

2nd Grade – While the students were studying the Saints in their homerooms, we also discussed many things that the saints did during their lives. We looked at the prayer cards hanging in the art room (St. Mary, St. Joseph, St. Anthony, St. Mother Theodore Guerin, and others) and talked about the saints that some people are named after, like Michael, Cecilia, Brigitte, Norbert, and others. We discussed what kinds of things make us think of certain saints. For instance, Mary may have baby Jesus or the crucified Jesus in her arms. Others may have a bible or rosary to show their prayer life. This project allowed students to capture a saint without capturing the details of their face. When we do not focus on the details of the person, we can focus on their achievements and ideals.

3rd Grade – We watched a BBC video touring Henri Matisse's Chapel. The Chapelle du Rosaire de Vence (Chapel of the Rosary), often referred to as the Vence Chapel, is a small Catholic chapel located in the town of Vence on the French Riviera. Matisse designed and created the chapel for a nurse, Sister Jacques-Marie (Monique) Bourgeois. She took care of Matisse during a long recovery from cancer surgery. We created white windows using vibrant tissue paper in organic shapes like Matisse created and included black silhouettes of Christ, doves, roses, and other symbols that reminded us of Mary, Jesus, and our faith.

4th Grade – After looking at photos of the stained-glass windows at Holy Rosary Church and several other churches around the world, including images of Notre Dame de Paris's Rose windows, we talked about the religious images that these windows depict. We began our project by folding our black paper and then cutting simple shapes and symbols. We later opened the folds to reveal the shapes and then glued tissue paper and frosted paper to emulate the look of vibrant stained glass.

5th Grade – We talked about how our Catholic teachings can inspire us to be like Christ. We talked about the Saints that inspire us to be strong in faith, especially Saints Mary and Joseph. After finding inspiration from the Russian artist Marc Chagall's dream-like art like *White Crucifixion* (1938), *The Madonna of the Village* (1938-1942), and *I and the Village* (1911), we created a mix of symbols and images from the life of Mary and Jesus, from our faith, and from what could look like our dreams. We used soft pastels on white paper.

6th Grade – After taking a pictorial tour of the Holy Rosary church and school campus, we talked about the symbols, architecture, statues, and natural beauty that reminds us of our Catholic faith. We then looked at ways to draw using only black ink by stippling, scumbling, or creating hatching lines. We used Ultra fine-tipped Sharpie and felt-tipped markers on Bristol paper to complete the artwork.

7th Grade – We talked about Jesus and how He is depicted in artwork around the world. After looking at many images of Christ, students chose various colored media to create their portrait of Christ. Some options that students chose included watercolor paints, oil pastels, acrylic painting, metal carving, and or a mix of media.

8th Grade – After watching the video by the Catholic Relief Services with the Respect Life theme set by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, we talked about the choices we make to respect others. The video states, "As Catholics, we believe that every life is sacred, from the moment of conception until natural death. Every person is made in the image and likeness of God and so each and every person has inherent dignity." Students were shown how to make sculptures using wire clothes hangers, nylon socks, and a piece of wood. Some students chose to manipulate the wire to look like a symbol of our faith or of a story from the bible. Others chose to create an abstract 3D form then paint the form with symbols.

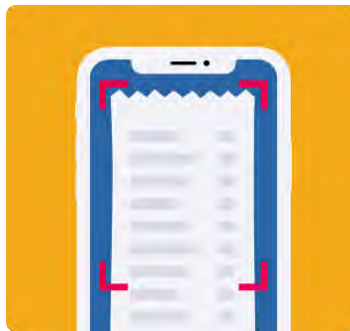

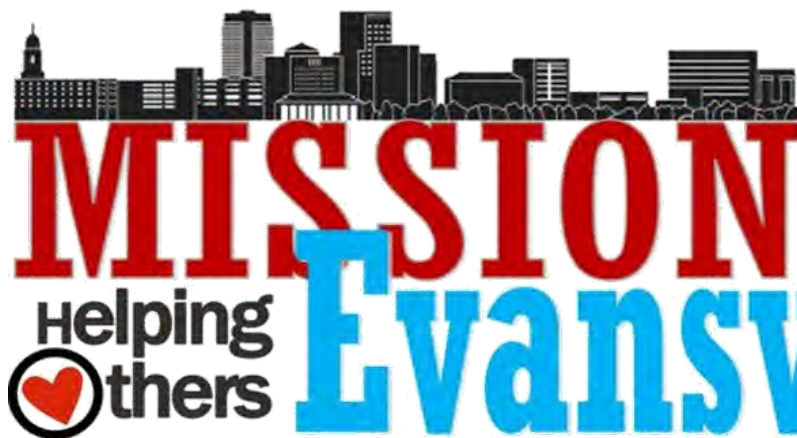
