Walking/Riding Track Update

Adding a walking track and riding track to our school and parish community encourages an active wellness culture and helps make it a better place to live for everyone. There are a couple of matching grants that we plan to pursue. All donations will continue to be accepted as we are actively fundraising for the multiphase project.

We are anxious to move forward. At this time, we are consulting with local companies to begin preparation on the walking/riding track for the Totten Hall playground. This is a much smaller project and will give us enlightenment for the larger walking track. Once again, we thank you for your support of making Holy Rosary a happy and healthier community.



After School Care Pick-Up Holy Rosary School



We know it can be hectic in the afternoons with multiple events taking place at our Holy Rosary School Campus. <u>Our students' safety is our top priority!</u> We appreciate everyone following the procedures below as it is difficult to see children around parked cars. *PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!*

Pick-up Procedures

1. Enter Holy Rosary property at the driveway by the church or the traffic light off Green River Road.

2. Park in a designated parking spot and <u>not along the fence or curb</u>. The first row of parking (by the large tree) is designated for Totten Hall and After School Care ONLY from 3:00-5:30PM.

When children are **INSIDE SCHOOL**:

- K-8 Parents will look for the BLUE flag. If students are in the gym, park by the gym entrance. If the BLUE flag is by preschool, park in the back lot and use the buzzer at door 6 to pick up your students.
- PS/PK Parents will park in the back lot and use the buzzer at door 6 to pick up your students.

When children are OUTSIDE/PLAYGROUND:

- K-8 Parents should park by the third gate (north end by the swings and basketball goals). Check students out with the supervisor at the gate.
- PS/PK Parents should park in the parking spots by the large tree in back of school. Check students out with the supervisor at the first gate by the preschool playground.


